The Beatles' genius didn't stop with "Abbey Road," and the AfterFab brings the brilliant solo careers of Lennon, McCarthy, Harrison and Starr to life. It's a tribute band that never existed except in the imagination of Beatles fans worldwide. Hear those classic post-breakup songs together in live performance, as if the fab ones had never split.
